Refined Japanese noodle soup and real bubble tea!

On 16 November RamenRamen also opened its doors in the Duinhal. For some of us a well-known name from Market33 on the Amsterdam Zuidas. Where owner Toan quickly made a name for himself in 2018 with his first Ramen food stand. The ramen noodle soup, which is still unknown in the Netherlands, has its origins in Japan, where this delicacy is distinguished by the quality of its ingredients, such as the use of grain-based noodles and the slowly drawn broth full of flavor and nutrients.

When Toan moved to Zandpoort with his family in 2019 and saw the first impressions of the Duinhal, he decided to open a second location to expand his menu there and to provide Duin with real bubble tea in addition to noodle soup in the future.

For those who want to try real Ramen, Toan points directly to his signature 'Tonkotsu' Ramen.

Peter Faber was a well-known resident in Zuiderduin and has done a lot for the neighborhood. Just before he left Zuiderduin to look for adventure, we spoke to him again and thanked him for his commitment to the neighborhood!

We hope that this also inspires other residents in Zuiderduin to do just that little bit more for your living environment, your neighbors, the neighborhood.

In addition to keeping track of the new residents in Zuiderduin, Peter was known for the handy technical tips on Facebook. But above all, Peter has ensured that we have saved an AED for the neighborhood in a short time via a Facebook crowdfunding campaign. This is placed at the height of ...

The residents' association takes over its tasks and keeps track of the new residents as well as possible for an introduction to the residents' association. This is no longer done via Facebook. The board keeps track of this for keeping track of the memberships and recruiting new members. The list is only known to the board. Non-members will be removed from this list after they have not paid membership for one year.

The subsidy that the municipality gave for the maintenance of the AED was also transferred by Peter to the residents' association. The residents' association therefore takes care of the maintenance of the AED.

Membership fee

Things are moving in the right direction

We are pleased to report that the efforts to collect the membership fee of 20 euros per year from all households are starting to pay off.

Compared to previous years, more residents have also paid the contribution this year. The number of tenants who pay is still low, 14%, compared to 73% of owners (owner-occupied homes). Of the total number of homes, 225, 33 residents have authorized us to have the contribution transferred from their bank account. If you have not yet paid for this calendar year, the contribution is € 20 per year and our bank account number is NL82INGB0007630892, attn. Bewonersvereniging Zuiderduin; please mention your address.

At the beginning of next year, January, it will be possible, via our website, to register so that you are an official member of our association, where you will have the opportunity to authorize the annual payment of the contribution.

If you have not paid for a year, your membership expires and you can no longer participate in the general meeting of members. One year later, we will delete your registration data.

During the general meeting of members, the board justifies what the money was spent on. Such as the Christmas lights, mini library, shed for stuff, New Year's drink, summer party etc. The finance committee checks the financial documents.

Playground equipment Dune

In the dune gardens there are climbing trees in various places. At the height of the Dune between Duinstraat and Duinbosstraat, 6 climbing poles and a beautiful bench will be placed instead of the climbing tree and the current bench. At the beginning of the Duintopstraat a tumbling rack will be placed. Onethere is a football field on the beach.

Kinderen can play in Almere, outside school hours, on the playground of the primary schools in the district.

The playground of o.b.s. "De Zeeraket" in the Kreekbos is now ready. There is a.o. a slide, tumbling racks and a real climbing web for tough spider kids! Furthermore, there is a large basketballcourt / playarea.



There will be more play facilities in Duin, including at primary school "De Duinvlinder". But because of the construction work, patience is still needed.

The municipality will keep us informed when the concrete plans are known.
